The Audley Foundation awarded The Care Worker's Charity (CWC) with a total of £15,000 . The grants are used to financially assist current care workers who are experiencing hardship. These grants help cover essential living expenses, health and wellbeing and/or promote independence. 
1) Overall summary of grant giving activities
